
As per the latest data, photos of about 15.80 lakh voters in 21 constituencies were not updated in the vot-ers' list. There are about 68



The administration has said that the latest voters' list has is available at the office of the electoral registration officer and also at www.pume.nc.in.











After login to the required BLO/ Ward, select Part No. from the drop down list, then please enter required Serial number and click on search




If we search for wrong Serial number it will show error that "this serial number is not available in residual list"





After using correct details, user is redirected to following screen having details of the voter like Serial No, Part No, Voter name, Gender, Age which will help to identify correct voter.


After that user have to click on the "camera & take" button to capture the photograph of voter.


